## Welcome Fall!

Please remember to sign your child in and out every day.

Please make sure your child is arriving to school on time.

Morning drop off begins at **8:15 AM** and ends at **8:45 AM**.

School begins at 8:30 AM and our school policy is no drop offs after 9 AM unless it's for a medical appointment. This helps our classes move smoothly throughout the morning without being interrupted. If you are utilizing the Car Drop Off Line please do not enter the building. If you would like to enter the building with your child, you must park in the parking lot.

If your child is sick, please send your child's teacher a message through Sandbox or call the office. This helps us know who we are expecting for the day. If you call before our church office is open, please leave a message and it will get passed on to us.

On Friday October 28, the whole school will be taking a field trip to Mayse Farm. There will be **no school** on Friday after the field trip. Please meet us at Mayse by 8:45 AM. All students must have a parent or guardian accompany them on the trip. Parents, if you are unable to attend, please mark on the permission slip who will be attending with your child. Due to FSSA regulations, we are unable to set up carpools for students or transport them. The cost is \$7/person. We ask that siblings stay home for this trip. We have a maximum number of people allowed to attend and we would like to make sure our students can fill these spots. If there are open spots closer to the trip, we may allow siblings on a first come, first serve basis. Each child will receive his/her own pumpkin to take home. We will also have access to the playground, jumping pillow, corn maze, slide, and all photo props.

Don't forget to wear your Trinity shirt. Please make sure your child is dressed for the weather. Field trips do continue even in the rain. Rain boots, hats, and coats can be kept in the car in case the weather would change. Mayse does allow you to go out to your car if needed.

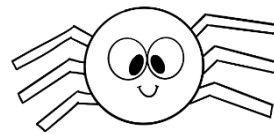
All Tuesday/Thursday students are welcome to attend this field trip. A permission slip is attached to this newsletter. Please return permission slips by **Friday October 21**.
