Mayse Farm Field Trip

On Friday October 27, the whole school will be taking a field trip to Mayse Farm. There will be **no school** on Friday after the field trip. Please meet us at Mayse by 8:45 AM. All students must have a parent or guardian accompany them on the trip. Parents, if you are unable to attend, please mark on the permission slip who will be attending with your child. Due to FSSA regulations, we are unable to set up carpools for students or transport them. The cost is \$7/person. We ask that siblings stay home for this trip. We have a maximum number of people allowed to attend and we would like to make sure our students can fill these spots. If there are open spots closer to the trip, we may allow siblings on a first come, first serve basis. Each child will receive his/her own pumpkin to take home. We will also have access to the playground, jumping pillow, corn maze, slide, and all photo props.

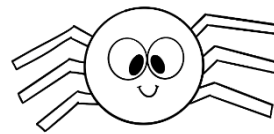
