By updating your account, your emergency contacts will be allowed to pick up with their own passcode. Please make sure all allergies/medical conditions are listed in your child's account as well.

If you are planning on ordering Scrip at any time this school year, please keep in mind that orders need to be in by the 15th of every month. Orders typically take a week or less to arrive, but that is not guaranteed. Please plan ahead with your ordering in case there are mail delays. It is a great program to help cut the cost of tuition.

BACK TO SCHOOL REMINDERS



If you are walking into the building, please make sure you are parking in the parking lot. Please do not park in the car drop off lane or in front of the church. Remember, curbside drop off is available every morning.

Please do not let your child come into school with gum or candy in the morning. We will ask them to spit it out.

Please make sure to sign your child in and out. We have had quite a few children that are not being signed in at drop off or signed out at pick up. Your passcode is the last 4 digits of your cell phone number.

Please make sure to follow our traffic flow pattern. We have had multiple vehicles entering in the east driveway. Please make sure to enter in the west (gravel) driveway. This helps keep our students safe.

Drop off is between 8:15-8:45 AM. Our doors are locked at 8:45 AM. Please remember our policy is no drop offs after 9 AM (with the exception of medical appointments).

If your child is sick, please make sure to call and leave a voicemail or send a Sandbox message so that we know your child will not be attending.

If you pay your tuition via cash/check, you do not have to pay the \$1.00 Online processing fee that is automatically applied to your Sandbox invoice. If you paid the fee accidentally, the \$1.00 was credited to your account.

Please note, our teachers are not required to answer Sandbox messages outside of work hours. If you send a message after hours, you may not get a response until the next morning.

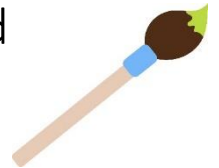
We are excited to get to know your children this year!

BEFORE SCHOOL CARE

We offer drop-in before school care on an as needed basis. The cost for drop-in before care is \$10/day. If you will be needing Before Care on a regular basis and would like to enroll in before care, please see Mrs. Smith. If you're enrolled in before care, the cost is \$18/week for 1-2 days OR \$25/week for 3-5 days. You must be enrolled in before care to receive the lower pricing.
