



Virtual Preschool- Day 1

<p>Pretend Play "farm animal charades" with a family member. Take turns acting out animals and guessing which animal is being acted out.</p> 	<p>Create This week, you will be making a farm mural. Today draw a big barn and silo. Use big paper if you can.</p> 
<p>Read There are so many good farm books. Try: -Duck on a Bike by David Shannon -Big Red Barn by Margaret Wise Brown -Pete the Cat: Old MacDonald had a Farm by James Dean</p> 	<p>Eat Lots of healthy food comes from the farm. Look in your fridge and find foods that came from a farm. Eat some of your farm foods for lunch.</p> 
<p>Ride In today's story the duck was riding a bike. Take a bike ride with a grown up. Remember to stay safe and wear your helmet!</p> 	<p>Help Farmers need to water their crops. Help your grown up by watering the plants at your house today.</p>

Virtual Preschool- Day 2


<p>Draw Today we will be adding a cow to our mural. What color will your cow be? How many spots will it have? Draw a picture of a cow and add it to your farm.</p> 	<p>Experiment Making butter is a fun and easy experiment. Just add heavy whipping cream to a jar with a tight lid (ex. Mason jar) and shake! It will turn into butter if you keep shaking.</p> 
<p>Rhyme A cow says "MOO" How many words can you name that rhyme with moo. - Clue - Do - Boo - Two - New</p>	<p>Taste Cows make milk. Look in your fridge for a dairy product. Have a taste of something made with milk. (yogurt, milk, ice cream, Butter, cheese)</p> 
<p>Imagine In the story, the cows typed a letter to the farmer. Imagine you are a cow on his farm. What would you ask for?</p>	<p>Read Today's story is "Click, Clack, Moo" by Doreen Cronin. It is a free audiobook on Amazon.</p> 

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Virtual Preschool- Day 3

<p>Play Play "Hide & Go Sheep" with your family. One person is the sheepdog and counts to ten while the others (sheep) hide. When the sheep dog barks, the sheep have to "Baa" as loudly as they can. Will the sheepdog find all the sheep?</p>	<p>Recite Try saying this rhyme about sheep Mary had a little lamb Little lamb, little lamb Mary had a little lamb Whose fleece was white as snow. Everywhere that Mary went Mary went, Mary Everywhere that went Mary went The lamb was sure to go.</p>
<p>Search Sheep are fuzzy. Look around you house for 10 things that are fuzzy like a sheep.</p>	<p>Draw Today we will be adding a sheep to our mural. Draw a fuzzy sheep and add it to your farm mural.</p> 
<p>Help Sheepdogs round up sheep. Help out your parents and "round up" all your toys and put them away.</p>	<p>Read Today's story is "Farmer Brown Shears His Sheep" by Teri Sloat. You can find additional sheep books on Amazon.</p> 

Virtual Preschool- Day 4

<p>Sing There are lots of songs about the farm. Try singing "All Around the Farm" by Jack Hartmann today. You can find this song on YouTube.</p>	<p>Draw Today, draw hens and a rooster to add to your farm mural. Have your hens laid eggs?</p> 
<p>Write Chickens hatch out of eggs. Practice writing Ee for egg today. Make the short e sound like at the beginning of exercise and envelop.</p>	<p>Help Roosters help the farm by waking everyone up. With a grown up, plan how you can help in the morning.</p>
<p>Move When the sun is shining, go outside and move! Can you walk around clucking like a chicken? Strut like a rooster? Gallop like a horse? Waddle like a duck?</p> 	<p>Imagine Imagine the rooster didn't wake everyone up one day. Would the farmer wake up? Would the animals be taken care of? Make up a story about what would happen and tell your family.</p>

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Virtual Preschool- Day 5

<p>Draw Today we will be adding a farmer to your mural. Add a farmer, a tractor, and any other animals you want on your farm. When you are finished, hang your farm mural up on the fridge!</p>	<p>Create Use play dough and animal toys to make your own farm scene. What are the animals doing on your farm? What kind of tracks do they make in your play dough.</p>
<p>Play Play "Farmer Says" with someone in your family (like Simon Says) -Farmer says, "Moo like a cow" -Farmer says, Roll on the ground like a pig" -Farmer says, "Drive a tractor" -Farmer says, "Neigh like a horse"</p>	<p>Wash In today's story, Mrs. Wishy Washy wanted to give her animals a bath. Tonight, take a bubble bath. Ask a grown up if you can wash a toy in the bath.</p> 
<p>Pretend Pretend to be a farmer. Put on a hat, a bandana, and boots if you have them. Pretend to drive a tractor, ride a horse, milk a cow, and feed the animals.</p> 	<p>Read Today's story is Mrs. Wishy Washy by Joy Cowley. She wants to wash her animals! Other books you might like: - Duck on a Tractor by David Shannon -The Farmer's Away Baa! Neigh! By Ann Vittur Kennedy</p>

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
