



# Virtual Preschool- Day 1

<p><b>Move</b> Be a savanna animal: -March like an elephant -Stomp like a zebra -Snap like a crocodile -Roar like a lion -Stretch like a giraffe</p>	<p><b>Help</b> During the middle of the day, lions sleep a lot to save energy. Help your grown up change your sheets or make your bed so that you're ready to sleep like a lion tonight.</p>
<p><b>Observe</b> All week, we are going to be scientist who observe and learn about animals. Check out the Cincinnati zoo's Facebook page and choose a savanna animal to observe today!</p>	<p><b>Dance</b> In today's story, Gerald thinks he can't dance. Turn on your favorite music (Lion King soundtrack?) and dance like the animals in the book.</p> 
<p><b>Run</b> Cheetahs are the fastest animals on land! How fast can you run? Go outside with a grown-up and ask them to time you while you run.</p> 	<p><b>Read</b> Today's story is: "Giraffes Can't Dance" by Giles Andreae. Other fun books: -"1,2,3 to the Zoo" by Eric Carle -"A Parade of Elephants" by Kevin Henkes</p>

# Virtual Preschool- Day 2

<p><b>Move</b> Be a jungle animal: -Creep slowly like sloth -Leap high like a leopard -Crawl on your belly like an alligator -Act silly like a monkey -Growl like a tiger</p> 	<p><b>Help</b> The jungle is full of plants and flowers. Help an adult today by watering the plants and flowers at your house.</p>
<p><b>Observe</b> Today, observe a rainforest animal. Go to the Cincinnati zoo's Facebook and watch a rainforest animal. Their sloth is fun to watch.</p>	<p><b>Paint</b> Dip a string in some paint and drag it across the paper like a snake. Can you make your string snake coil up? Stretch out? Wiggle?</p>
<p><b>Bake</b> Important food is grown in the rainforest. Bananas, coffee, cinnamon, cocoa, and vanilla are just some foods grown in the rainforest. Bake cookies with your grown-up using rainforest ingredients. What kind of cookies are you going to make?</p>	<p><b>Color</b> Macaws are beautiful birds that live in the rainforest. Color a picture of a macaw. You can find one online or draw your own! Don't forget to use lots of bright colors.</p> 

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## Virtual Preschool- Day 3


<p><b>Pretend</b> Pretend to be a polar animal: -Waddle like a penguin -Growl like a polar bear -Clap your hands like a seal -Howl like a wolf -Hoot like an owl</p>	<p><b>Paint</b> Ask a grown up to help you freeze food color mixed with water in an ice cube tray. After it is frozen, use it to paint a chilly picture.</p> 
<p><b>Observe</b> Observe penguins on the Cincinnati zoo's Facebook page. How many types of penguins do they show in their video?</p>	<p><b>Experiment</b> Icebergs float on the water. Fill up a big bowl of water and find small items around your house that you can test. Do they sink or float?</p>
<p><b>Search</b> Penguins and Polar Bears both start with the letter P. Find items in your house that also start with the letter P.</p> 	<p><b>Move</b> Polar Bear, Polar Bear turn around. Polar Bear, Polar Bear touch the ground. Polar Bear, Polar Bear growl real loud. Polar Bear, Polar Bear take a bow!</p>

## Virtual Preschool- Day 4

<p><b>Pretend</b> Pretend to be a forest animal: -Growl like a bear -Fly like an eagle -Howl like a coyote -Hop like a rabbit -Tweet like a bird -Prance like a deer</p> 	<p><b>Create</b> Make easy forest animal shadow puppets. Cut out pictures and tape them to popsicle sticks or straws. Grab a flashlight and put on a shadow puppet show in your blanket tent.</p>
<p><b>Observe</b> Go outside and observe animals at your house. Can you spot birds or squirrels? You can also visit the Cincinnati zoo's Facebook page and watch eagles.</p>	<p><b>Sing</b> "Gray squirrel, gray squirrel swish your bushy tail. Gray squirrel, gray squirrel swish your bushy tail. Hold a nut between your toes. Wrinkle up your little nose. Gray squirrel, gray squirrel swish your bushy tail."</p>
<p><b>Build</b> Forest animals live in dens, burrows, or nests. When people visit the forest, they stay in a tent. Make a blanket tent and pretend to go camping.</p> 	<p><b>Color</b> Color a picture of animals that you might find in the forest. Add trees, grass, and other forest things.</p> 

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# Virtual Preschool- Day 5

<p><b>Pretend</b> Pretend to be an ocean animal:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>-Move your arms like an octopus</li><li>-Snap like a shark</li><li>-Walk like a crab</li><li>-Slide like a starfish</li><li>-Leap like a dolphin</li></ul> 	<p><b>Create</b> Use a sponge and dab blue paint on paper. Add some fish and other ocean animals to your painting after it dries.</p>
<p><b>Observe</b> Today you can visit ocean animals by checking out the South Carolina Aquarium's Facebook page. What animals did you observe?</p>	<p><b>Draw</b> Go outside and draw an ocean scene with chalk. What color are your fish? Did you draw a shark?</p> 
<p><b>Write</b> Ocean and octopus start with the letter O. Practice writing the letter O. Remember to start at the top and go around.</p> 	<p><b>Relax</b> Take a bath. Pretend you are a fish swimming in the ocean. Put on goggles (if you have them) and pretend that you are a scuba diver looking for ocean animals.</p>

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
